

ISSF CONSERVATION MEASURE 3.5 SAPMER NON-ENTANGLING FAD POLICY

- Since January first, 2012, SAPMER SA does not permit its vessels to deploy Fishing Aggregation Device (FAD) presenting entanglement risks.
- This non-entangling FAD Policy is based on our Producer Organization ORTHONGEL Decision n°11 dated November 23rd, 2011, which is available at the following link: http://orthongel.fr/docs/reglt/orthongel/Dec11-DCPeco.pdf
- The characteristics and engineering of non-entangling FAD were determined during the "tuna for tomorrow program ECO FAD" and are consistent with ISSF Guide for nonentangling FAD.

- This policy and the associated technical means have been developed since then in a process of continuous improvement.
